

8.C.2 Annual WIA Program Performance Report for Program Year 2005 –
(Information/Discussion)

Annually, the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) determines program performance and reports the information to the Department of Labor (DOL). DWD has finalized the performance report for Program year 2005. This report is a compilation of all 11 WDA's performance and is used to issue incentive funds to top performers and sanctions to poor performing WDBs. State level incentive funds are granted to WDBs who have Exceeded or Met all performance measures. SWWDB has historically ranked among the top performing WDA's in Wisconsin.

For Program Year 2005, SWWDB "Exceeded" 15 of the performance measures, "Met" one measure and "Failed" one. The item SWWDB "Failed" was the Younger Youth Retention Rate, a measure the SWWDB has historically "Exceeded." The Department of Workforce Development (DWD) made some programming changes that created errors in data compilation. SWWDB corrected some of the errors, but was not advised that 10 records remained incorrect. DWD submitted the errors to DOL and SWWDB was recorded with a "Failed" measure.

Attachment 1 is a report showing the performance results for the eleven (11) workforce development areas by performance measure. **Attachment 2** is a comparison of how the 11 WDAs ranked in performance over the past five years.
