- * Must be 18+;
 - * Must be convicted of current charges;
 - * Reside in a state, county, or local facility— No federal institutions;
- ⇒ OR, federal halfway houses, DOC residential facilities, home confinement program, or other electronic monitoring program.
- * Have between 20-180 days remaining until planned exit date;
 - * Returning to an eligible county;
 - * Are legally eligible to work in the US;
 - * Veterans receive priority consideration.

PATHWAYS Home 2 can provide eligible individuals who are incarcerated in state correctional facilities, or local or county jails, with workforce development services prior to their release, and following their transition back into the community. The program is job-driven and builds on connections with local employers that will enable transitioning individuals to obtain meaningful employment post-release.

What Can Pathways Home 2 Provide?

- ⇒ Career Services and employment assistance
- ⇒ Financial assistance for educational resources, including tuition, books, fees, and supplies;
- ⇒ Financial assistance for training programs and skill development;
- ⇒ Financial assistance for support, including childcare, transportation, vehicle repairs, uniforms, tools and equipment, lap tops, housing, utilities;
- ⇒ Financial assistance for outpatient substance use and mental health treatment services, including IDP assessments.

Career Services

- ⇒ Resume assistance
- ⇒ Employment coaching
- ⇒ Job preparation
- ⇒ Job search assistance
- ⇒ Referral to local employers and assistance in securing meaningful employment
- ⇒ Skills Assessments
- ⇒ Service referrals, including housing, legal, benefits, and other workforce development programming
